## STREET TAG

We are delighted to announce that Flimby Primary School will be continuing to participate in the Street Tag Cumbria Schools Leaderboard program. This means we are in competition with other schools.

With Street Tag, participants record the distance they walk, run, or cycle by collecting virtual tags with their smartphone at various locations, watching their total distance accumulate to climb up the Schools leaderboard; steps are converted into points by syncing their steps into the Street Tag app. This is designed to encourage families to walk and cycle to school, to be physically active, to connect with green spaces, and is an opportunity to rediscover their local area as well as earn rewards for their school.
